

Matorka Environmental Policy Statement

Matorka responsibly raises the finest quality fish in harmony with Iceland's natural environment and is recognised as a trusted and valued corporate citizen while working towards its vision of being the world-leading supplier of premium Arctic char. Matorka seeks excellence in every aspect of the business and is committed to best-practice sustainability throughout the entire value chain, minimising environmental impacts while growing a culture of environmental stewardship throughout all activities and processes.

Matorka has already included the following environmental best practices:

- a. 100% of electricity is supplied by way of sustainable geothermal energy.
- b. 100% of fish waste from processing plant is allocated to approved agri-feed and bioenergy, thus zero organic waste from processing activities.
- c. Hybrid flow-through production systems with reduced energy requirements.
- d. Prioritising the use of sustainable and responsibly sourced feed ingredients that are traceable, non-GMO, and sourced from suppliers with environmentally sound practices.
- e. Submission of carbon emission data since 2014 by supporting a local registered tree planting offsetting program.
- f. Sustainable Aquaculture Certifications obtained from ASC and Global GAP.

As Matorka we deliver on our environmental commitment by:

- 1. Complying with all applicable environmental legislation and sustainability requirements and commitments.
- 2. Measuring and analysing the carbon footprint of our business activities in conjunction with other climate change mitigation and adaptation efforts.
- 3. Setting objectives and targets to enhance our environmental performance and reduce our carbon emissions.
- 4. Preventing pollution and reducing consumption of resources through waste management strategies and circularity that promote waste minimization (including scope 1, 2 and 3 carbon emissions).
- 5. Continuously improving the efficient use of resources.
- 6. Adhering to sustainable procurement through promoting the purchasing and use of sustainable products with limited environmental impacts.
- 7. Complying to our sustainability certifications.
- 8. Promoting the protection and conservation of biodiversity.

- 10. Monitoring external environmental risks and ensuring the management thereof where possible.
